Students are reading and completing an independent project with some assignments using a book of their choice. Several students are already turning in late work.

Math - Usually we have a daily Simple Solutions Monday - Thursday from our book, with a quiz on Fridays. Many students are not completing the daily Simple Solutions in their book, and are quite far behind, which is contributing to poor quiz grades. The daily Simple Solutions book work will be averaged for a weekly grade, so it is to the benefit of your student to be using their time wisely to complete the Simple Solutions of the day. The questions from the quiz are taken directly from the Simple Solutions book. Students should be asking for help on the ones they get wrong. Our next quiz will be on Simple Solutions 21-24. Algebra - We are writing equations for parallel and perpendicular lines.
