Thank you for the paper towel/wipes donations! They are very much appreciated! It looks like we finally have some spring weather! The kids have been so excited to go out for recess without their coats, and we are looking forward to spending more time outside.





I am having a hard time believing that
May starts next week! Beginning May 1, students will
have the option of wearing their shorts/skorts with
their uniform shirt. Shorts/skorts must be solid
khaki, black or gray, unless it is a uniform plaid skort.
Shorts need to be no shorter than 2" above the knee.
I know this is hard when our kiddos are so small, but

please just make sure they are not "short" shorts. Thank you! Socks will still need to be solid white, gray or black. Knee socks must still be worn with jumpers, but shorter socks can be worn with shorts. Please let me know if you have any questions. Thank you!

Our kindergarten visit day is Monday afternoon. Preschool students will come and visit the kindergarten classroom from 12-2, and our students will be having fun in the preschool room with Mrs. Evans and

Mrs. Norton. This doesn't change the pick-up schedule at all. I just wanted you to be aware of the afternoon switch. I know the kids are excited to be visiting their old classroom!



We celebrated Earth Day this week, and planted beans and marigolds. We are learning about parts of a plant/tree, and the function of each part. We learned about St. George and the dragon, prayed the rosary for Pope Francis, practiced our spelling words outside with chalk, and continued to learn about place value in math. We have also been learning that Easter is not just for a day, but is an entire season in which we are joyful for Jesus' rising from the dead. We are also working on fixing "silly sentences" that have missing punctuation or misspelled words. Students are doing a great job with these! We did NOT take our spelling



test this week. The "ch" and "sh" sounds are somewhat tricky, and I noticed the kids having a harder time than usual with these words. We will continue to practice these words for next week.
