Report Cards

With report cards, just around the corner, I thought I would review the grading scale for first grade. Some of the standards that are graded, we have only learned part of that standard. Students can not be proficient until we have learned the "entire" standard.

The students are doing a great job! Here is the grading scale:

PROFICIENT (PR) - Student demonstrates complete understanding of the task every time without assistance.

Developing (DV) - Student has just been introduced to the concept or he/she is able to complete the task most of the time, but may need assistance or he/she may not be completely accurate.

NOT YET (NY) - Student is not able to complete the task yet.
