Dear school families,

On Sunday, we celebrate our parish feast day. Let us rejoice on this day and be thankful and feel blessed to have our wonderful Catholic parish and school named after St. Charles Borromeo.

Updates for the coming week:

- Look for an email letting you know when report cards will be ready for viewing.** There have certainly been several issues with our new process. The new report card will look very different from previous years. There are many, many standards. Obviously, teachers would never get to all the standards in one quarter. Therefore, many standards won't have a mark. Please do not worry about that. In addition, you will not see the typical 1, 2, 3 system for assessing work habits, etc. We will be using the following for marks: PR for proficient, DV for developing, CN for consistently, NY for not yet, and NE for not evaluated. Summative grades, however, will use the typical grading letters of A, B, C, D in grades 4 – 8. Work and study habits will use the PR, DV, CN, NY, and NE letters. Some teachers had already started using the letters P, D, M before these changes were made diocesan-wide. I have told the teachers to leave as is for this marking period, as this is a very involved process unlike one the teachers have done before. Again, please understand that this is new to all of us, and we are working very hard with the diocesan experts to work out any problems. Feel free to contact me if you have questions. If I cannot answer you, I will reach out to get the correct answer for you. Thank you for your patience.

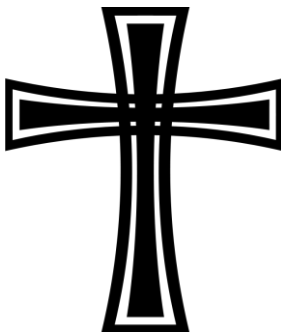
