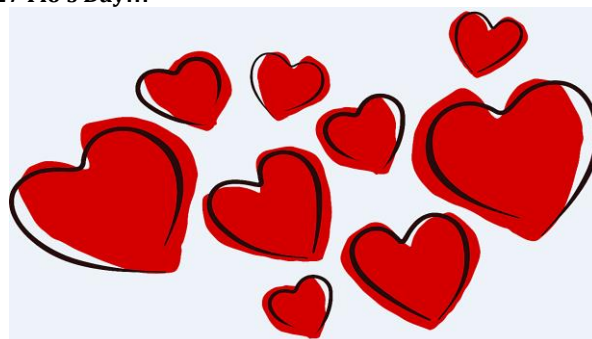

### Scrip Corner

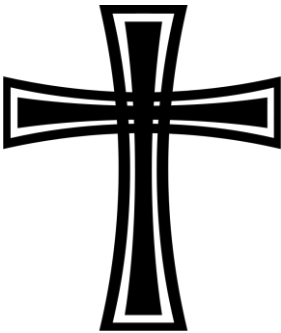
Be sure to check out all the different ways you can use scrip for your vacations. There are airline and hotel scrip for your use.
