Dear school families,

As we attend Mass this weekend, we hear Luke's narrative of the Transfiguration, which subtly points toward the cross. Moses and Elijah appear and speak to Jesus about "his exodus that he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem." Exodus means "going out," and Jesus goes out of this material life in Jerusalem when his blood is spilled on the cross. He dies because we did not keep the covenant. By his death, it becomes clear that God does keep the covenant he made with Abraham. (taken from *Catechist*, March 2019, p. 38)
