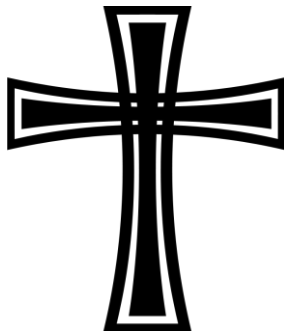
Candy Bar Sale!
