The **Franciscan Life Process Center** is a non-profit organization that focuses on providing services that support healthy human development.

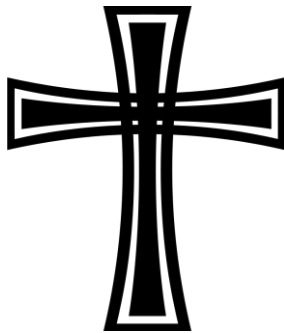
Each year, this event promotes the work of their counseling programs to educate and offer personal support towards achieving mental health.
