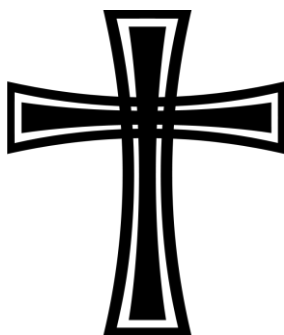
### Candy Bar Sale!
