Set aside an hour each week to sit before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. In the quiet of his presence, praise and thank him for becoming a

man and saving you from sin and death. Serve the needy in some way. Volunteer at a food kitchen, buy gifts for a struggling family or help decorate the home of an elderly neighbor.

See where you have strayed from God. Then go to confession and receive his forgiveness and the grace to follow him more closely. Is there anyone you need to forgive? Ask Jesus to help you forgive that person, and then reconcile with them if possible.
