I do hope that your family has a nice long weekend. I know that some of you will be traveling, so please be safe.

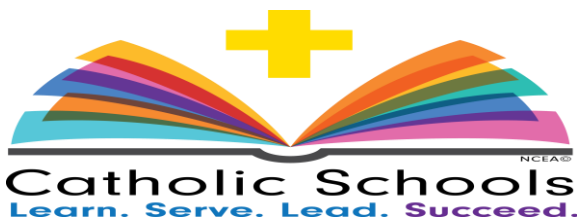
