This reminds us that seeking justice may not be necessary in every situation. Letting go of wrongs that are not actually harmful is one way we grow in righteousness. It is a way of not letting pride control our interactions with others. May God send us His Spirit to strengthen us in love and to give us wisdom to know which hurts need our response and which we can let go and give to Him. 
