2 Stations of the Cross 1:25 PM This Sunday, we celebrate the first Sunday of Lent. At Mass, we hear about Jesus' temptations in the desert. Jesus won out. Where once he heard only the devil's words of harassment, now he heard angels singing songs of comfort and praise. We will be tempted this Lent. The devil will try to convince us that God doesn't care about us or that obeying the commandments will leave us unsatisfied. Let us hold fast to our Lenten commitments. M14) Students will be praying the Stations of the Cross on Mondays at 1:25 in church. Feel free to join us. We have been talking to our students about prayer, fasting and almsgiving especially during this beautiful season of Lent. Students are asked to fill out a slip of paper each week noting their weekly Lenten sacrifice. Students will bring these up to the altar during the offertory procession at the Friday all school **18 No PM Busing** Masses. Please encourage your child/children to think about ways that they can grow closer to Christ by offering small sacrifices throughout the Lenten season. Please remember that school is NOT in session on Friday, March 6. Teachers will be participating in Classroom Learning Labs throughout the diocese. Teachers have chosen to visit other diocesan teachers who will be teaching content that L supports their own grade level/interest. The following Friday, March 13, we will host two Classroom Learning Labs. Mrs. Hamman and Mrs. Kemp will be hosting teachers from other Catholic schools. 
