Dear school families,

Sunday's readings reference the central theme of forgiveness and the importance of showing God's mercy to others to receive it ourselves. In the gospel, Jesus uses the parable of the unforgiving servant to teach of the need to always forgive our neighbor. As recited in the Lord's Prayer and detailed in the readings of Sunday's Mass, we are challenged to demonstrate our desire for God's unconditional love and compassion through our daily practice of the Golden Rule. #### Things to know:

- If you are still having trouble logging into Canvas, please first let your child's teacher know, as the pairing codes that were sent out earlier only last for seven days. We can also contact the Diocese if you need more assistance.
- MAPS testing has begun. This is the testing program used by all Catholic schools in the diocese. Students in grades 2 8 will test in math, language arts and reading. In addition, students in grades 4 8 will also test in science. The data from the tests helps your child's teacher determine what each student already knows and what each student still needs to learn. The MAPS testing program gives staff detailed information about your child's growth throughout their school years at St. Charles. Please be sure that your child has a healthy breakfast during the next three weeks and brings a water bottle to school. A good night of sleep is also important.
- The Monday Charity Day (jean day) will support the Bishop's Emergency Disaster Relief Fund. These donations will support Catholic Charities (USA) and Catholic Relief Services. All children who are not in uniform must donate a gift of 50 cents or more to this cause. Please be generous. Thank you.


