Just a reminder that if you wish to send in birthday treats, all treats need to be store-bought items that are individually wrapped.

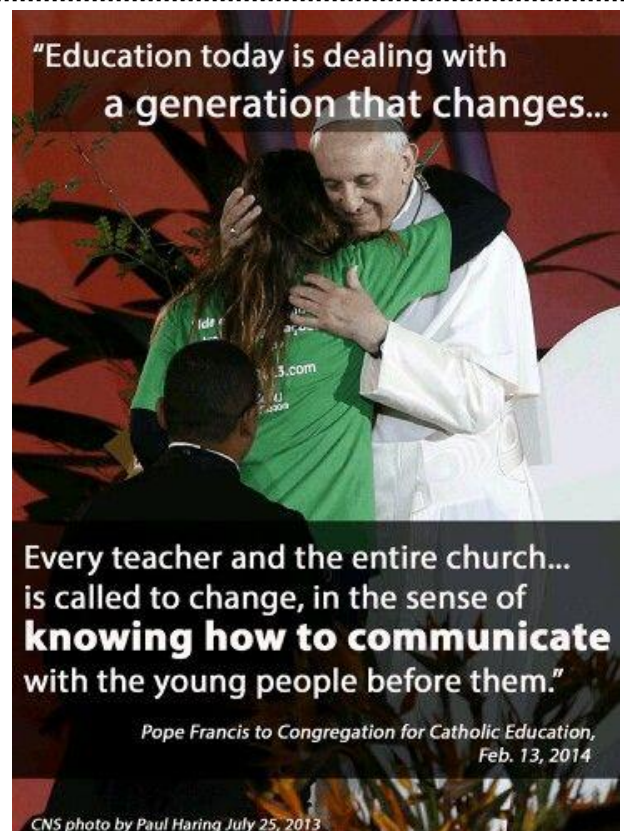
