Dear school families,

It has been a great first week back to school after Christmas break. The teachers and I were so excited to see your children.

This Sunday, we celebrate the Baptism of our Lord. Jesus is baptized by John, and God's voice proclaims Jesus to be the Beloved Son of God with the visible presence of the Holy Spirit bearing witness. Let us listen for echoes of our own baptism and the baptisms we have witnessed: water, Spirit, the Trinity, a faith-filled community gathered. Celebrate your baptism date anniversary. As we continue to stay healthy and safe in our school, I want to just send a few reminders to you.

- If you have a child exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, the whole family needs to stay home until test results are obtained. Family members are considered close contacts and have to quarantine.
- If your child is a close contact, he or she must quarantine for 10 days after the last exposure to the person who is COVID positive.

What are the scenarios for virtual learning?

- A parent chooses virtual learning for their child due to health concerns.
- Parent/student tested positive for COVID-19. Student must quarantine or self-isolate and will miss 10-24 days of school.
- Student is considered a close contact of a person positive for COVID-19, must quarantine, and will miss several consecutive days of school.
- Student/Parent/Family member is waiting for COVID-19 test results and must stay home until test results are received.
 Student may miss several consecutive days of school.
- Parents must inform the school if one of the above conditions is met. Teachers will work with families to switch student to virtual learning.
- If a student is learning virtually, absences must be reported to the school office. If a student does not participate in the virtual learning session that has been arranged by the teacher, the student will be marked absent.
- Special circumstances may occur to move a child to virtual learning.

Our Monday Charity/Jean Day will support the Monday and Thursday Community dinners. Please remember that students must bring a monetary donation in order to be out of uniform.

Parent-teacher conferences will be held virtually the weeks of January 25 and February 1. Teachers will be contacting you directly to set up a time to meet. It is very important that you meet with your child's teacher. We are a team working together, and teachers appreciate the time you will give to discuss your child with them.
