Dear school families,

Sunday's first reading is a very important religious text. While it is strange for us to read of God asking for human sacrifice, that was nothing out of the ordinary in Abraham's world. It is because of the story of Abraham and Isaac that human and child sacrifice looks the way it does to us. The story of Abraham and Isaac begins the trajectory that ends with Christ. We learn that the one who gave himself to be sacrificed so that we might see the truth about human sacrifice was God's own Son. (taken from *Living With Christ*, February 2021, p.192.)
