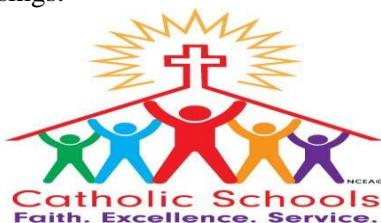
Thank you to all who have donated to the food drive for our St. Joseph's Table. We will collect non-perishable food until Friday, March 19. Thank you for your generosity.
