This Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of The Most Holy Trinity or Corpus Christi. There will be a Eucharistic Procession following the 11:00 a.m. Mass at St. Charles. Regardless of what Mass you choose to attend, all families are encouraged to join the Procession. A special invitation goes out to our new **First Communicants**, for whom this is a very significant feast. Children are asked to wear First Communion attire, as they will follow directly behind Father and the Canopy with the Monstrance. Behind them will be the **newly confirmed**, followed by **YM3** participants, then all families and parishioners. This is a wonderful tradition with a rich history.
