The second *Interact* meeting will be held on Tuesday at 7:00 a.m. We are thrilled to see many future leaders from this group of students who want to serve their school and community.

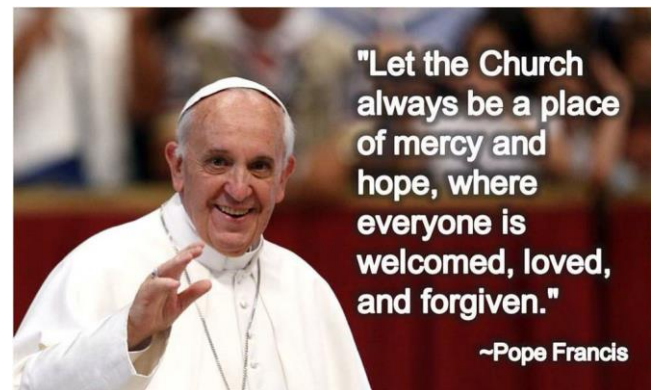
