Dear school families,

In our Gospel reading this week, we hear about Bartimaeus who knows what he wants: his sight. Furthermore, he has faith that he will get his sight even before he asks. Jesus cures Bartimaeus and reveals the key to the cure--his faith. We often cling to things that interfere with getting closer to God, such as envy, gluttony, greed, lust, pride, sloth and wrath. These sins are often confused with what we need and want. They distance us from God. Faith can help us find the way when we are blinded by confusion over what is important. 
