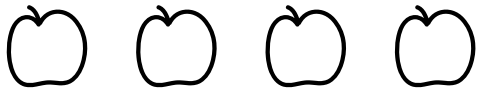

- water bottle

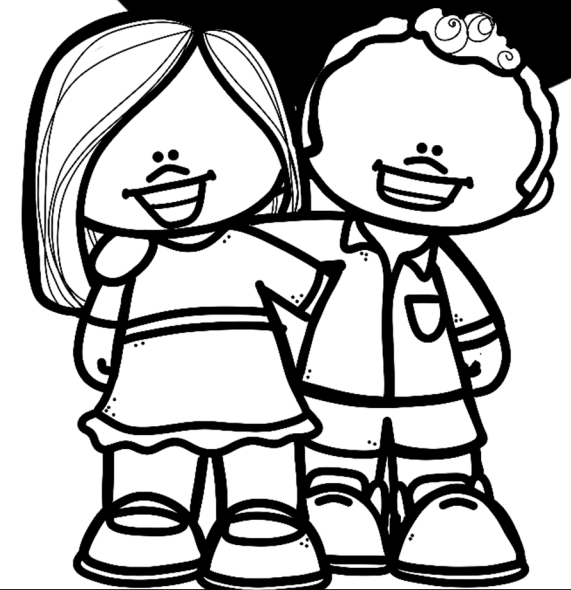
