Monday is a Charity Day benefiting God's Kitchen, here at St. Charles. They provide a hot meal to those in need in our community every Saturday.

SCIENCE - We are learning about Newton's Laws of Motion.

THEOLOGY - We are examining ways we respond to social injustices.
