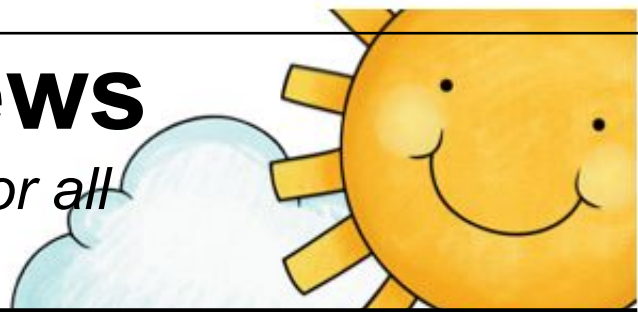

Report Card Information

I wanted to explain our first grade report card. Many of the standards that will be graded, we have only learned part of that standard at this point in the year. Students can't be proficient until they have learned and assessed the "entire" standard. When you look at your child's report card, you will see developing in many areas. The students are doing a great job, but we have not completed the entire standard in the first marking period. This is our grading scale:

PROFICIENT (PR) - Demonstrates complete understanding of the task every time and without assistance.

DEVELOPING (DV) - Student has just been introduced to the concept or he/she is able to complete the task most of the time, but may need assistance or may not be completely accurate.

NOT YET (NY) - Student is not able to complete the task yet.
