PIZZA SIGN-UP FOR THE SECOND HALF OF THE YEAR!

The second half of the year pizza sign-up is here! We will begin serving pizza for the last half of the year starting Monday, January 5th. Please click the link below and fill out the form if your child would like pizza. The cost is \$27.00 for one slice and \$54.00 for two. Money is due in the office before Christmas break!



Pizza Sign-up

If you're deciding between one slice or two, a few things might help. Students have about 20 minutes to eat, so think about how much your child typically finishes in that time. We don't have a convenient way to save a second slice if they aren't able to finish it. It can also be helpful to pack a couple of simple sides like chips and an apple to round out their lunch and make sure they have enough to eat.
