Our 2nd quarter ends soon and report cards will be marked. I will be reviewing these with you during parent-teacher conferences in February.

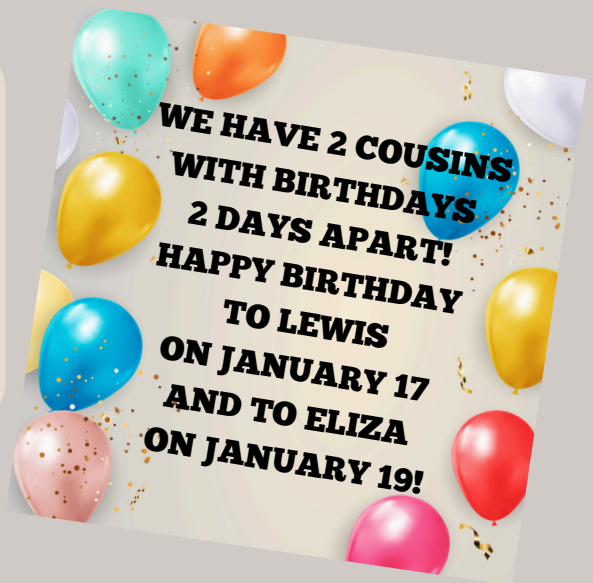
