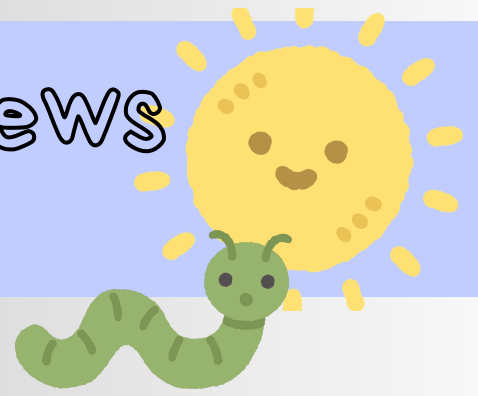


Kindergarten News

NEXT Sunday, March 29.

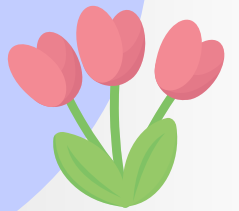
