# Preschool Newsletter

Happy Holy Week! We started this week learning about Palm Sunday. Jesus entered Jerusalem and the people welcomed Him by saying "Hosanna." We made palm branches using green construction paper, carefully cutting around the edges to make them look like real palms. We then role-played Jesus riding into Jerusalem, joyfully saying "Hosanna to our King!" We also learned about the Last Supper, when Jesus shared a special meal with His friends. We reenacted this important moment by breaking real bread and drinking red juice, remembering how Jesus shared the Eucharist. For our lesson on Good Friday, we learned that Jesus died on the Cross because He loves us. We talked about how Jesus showed the greatest love by giving His life for us. We created three crosses on a hill using colorful pieces of paper for the background. Finally, we celebrated the Resurrection! We learned that Jesus is alive, the tomb was empty, and He rose again. To celebrate, we had fun decorating Easter Bunny bags, as a special visitor may stop by our school on Easter to fill them with goodies!
