# Preschool Newsletter

Spring has arrived, and our classroom has been full of excitement as we explore the beauty and wonder of this special season. We have been learning all about growth, weather, and the amazing changes that happen all around us during spring.

We read the book "A Sunflower's Life Cycle" by Mary Dunn and painted pots before planting flowers. This helped us learn what it takes to grow and care for plants. We also read "Worm Weather" by Jean Taft and explored real nightcrawlers using magnifying glasses. The children loved observing them up close and learning how important worms are in helping plants grow. To learn about the weather, we read "Super Storms" by Seymour Simon. We talked about how and why tornadoes form and created our own tornado in a bottle using clear plastic bottles, duct tape, glue, water, food coloring and glitter. This fun experiment helped us see how a tornado spins and forms.
