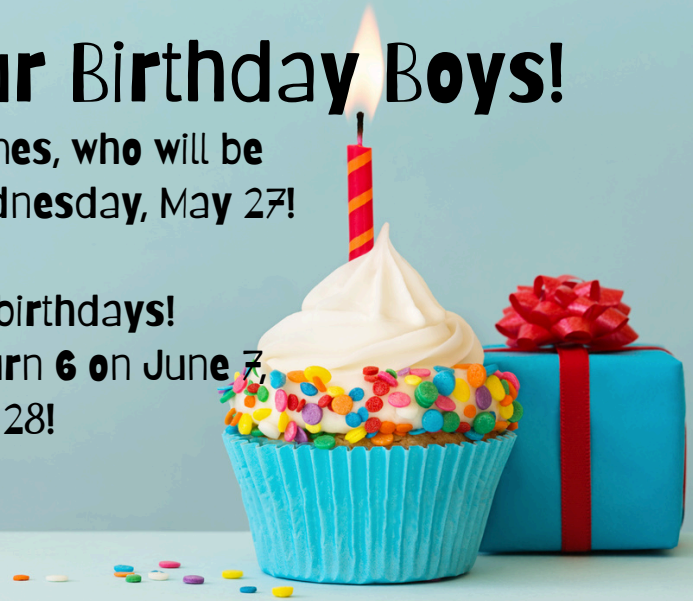


Celebrating our Birthday Boys!
