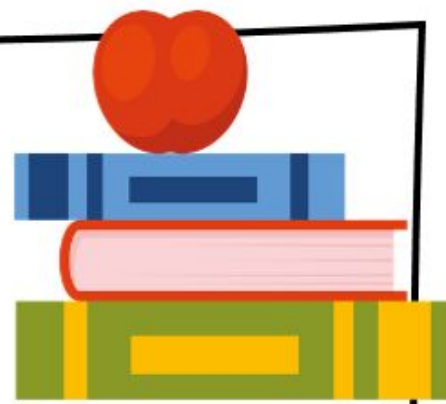

OUR LEARNING SNAPSHOT:

Writing: This week in writing we practiced writing skills with a fictional story about a dragon and a castle in the clouds.

Reading: In reading we we read Scaredy Squirrel as a class. Scaredy Squirrel is about a very cautious squirrel who is terrified of leaving his safe, familiar tree. He spends his days preparing for every possible danger—until one day, he is forced to venture outside. To his surprise, Scaredy Squirrel discovers that he is braver and more capable than he thought.

Grammar: This week, we practiced identifying question words.

Phonics: This week in phonics, we worked on learning medial blends and vowel blends. Next week, we will continue learning about vowel and consonant blends along with prefixes and suffixes.

Math: This week in math, we learned division and how to use arrays to find the quotient. Next week, will practice our multiplication and division strategies and will be having our first Math test on Wednesday.

Science: This week in science, we learned about the moon and the different phases of the moon. Next week we will be closing out this unit on the Sun, Moon and Earth with a test on Thursday

Religion: This week in Religion, we learned about the theological virtues. Next week we will learn about gifts of love and review for our test on Tuesday.
